FCC NTX Update - Scale Model and Project Plan 3

All:

The Essay deadline is past, but there is still an opportunity to submit files through 18 December with a small 5pt penalty.

PROJECT PLAN 3: Due 18 December.

The third piece of the Project Plan – Checkin – is due 18 December. Upload essay to NTX CMS: https://secure.dfwfuturecity.org/NorthTX/Teachers

NEXT PHASE IS SCALE MODEL –You should already be collecting recyclables for building materials for your scale model.

Also note that you have a choice: you can build a single city model (as we have in the past) or you can build multiple model sections that represent different portions of the city. The sections don't need to fit together physically. However, the maximum size for the total model: 25'' (w) x 50'' (l) x 20'' (h). There also needs to be a moving part.

The best models will show all types of zones (residential, commercial, and industrial) and some of the city infrastructure. And, you will want to include some aspect of your electrification solution, as well. The model (or model sections) must still be built to scale. You can use up to 4 different, but easily identifiable (to the judges) scales. See the list of Model Rules in the handbook, p. 43.
